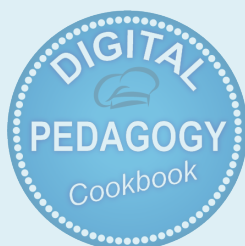

The development of the project

After the joint staff training, held in Berlin from 1 to 5 July and hosted by our partner iberika, significant steps forward had been done. In particular the partners defined the structure of the recipes that will form the cookbook.

Community Action Dacorum will host the next meeting, the third one, in Hemel Hempstead (UK). In the agenda, among other topics, the partners will better define the Intellectual Outputs number 3 and 4: the **Community of Practice for digital pedagogy** which will be an online social learning spaces for educators and educational planners, and the **Digital Pedagogy in VET** to apply and transfer the outcomes of the project to VET.

The RECIPES and the COOKBOOK

The **Cookbook** is the second Intellectual Output (IO2) and contains ninety recipes. Food is an essential topic, and it is the perfect starting point and common ground: We all eat and we all know how to **read** and **apply** a recipe!

In the last months, each partner created fifteen recipes according to their skills and area of expertise. It is an innovative tool to teach trainers how to use **digital pedagogy** with their students.
